Labiaplasty – Post-Operative Instructions

General Recovery

• You can sleep in any position that is comfortable.

• Avoid placing pressure on your labia for two weeks after surgery. Hard narrow seats should be avoided.

• Bleeding (minor) from your surgical site may occur following surgery. If it occurs hold constant firm pressure for 10-15 minutes with a clean towel. If bleeding persists or one side is becoming much larger than the other, see our emergency care instructions below.

• You should use a female sanitary pad for the first few nights after surgery.

• You may gradually resume normal daily activities after 48 hours, being careful to avoid any activity that causes pain or discomfort. Strenuous activities and exercises are to be avoided until 2-3 weeks after surgery. At that point, you may perform non-impact aerobics like the elliptical. Running, impact aerobics, and light upper body work can start once you are comfortable performing low impact exercises.

• Vaginal sexual intercourse should be avoided for 4 weeks following labiaplasty. Wait for your surgeon to reassess your incisions.

Washing & Healing

• You will likely notice some bruising and swelling, this is normal and will disappear in 7-14 days.

• Absorbable stitches are used. These will disintegrate within 3 weeks in most cases. The incisions are placed on the inner surface of the labia minora. This surface should be kept slightly moist with *Vaseline* or *Polysporin* to prevent dryness or crusting.

• You can shower 48 hours after surgery.

• Do not soak your surgical sites - no pools, hot tubs, lake or well water for 3-4 weeks.

• Unusual sensations like numbness, sharpness, and burning may occur during the healing process. These sensations may last several weeks and will gradually disappear.

Medication

• Anti-Pain medication can be taken after surgery.

• Resume prescribed medications unless otherwise stated (avoid fish oils and herbal supplements)

• Take antibiotics as prescribed at the appropriate times until completed.

Follow Up Care

• Dr. McInnes will let you know which location to visit him for your follow up appointments. Please call the office to confirm the time (604-515-8847). Dr. McInnes may call you the evening of surgery to see how you're doing, please try to answer your phone (even if it's from "unknown caller").

After Surgery Care
